Legal Requirements

The following information is provided for guidance only and must be confirmed by your superintendent registrar.

Giving Notice of Marriage

In order to be granted authority to marry, you are required to give notice of marriage to the superintendent registrar in the district where you reside. You must have been resident in that district for a minimum of seven days prior to giving notice.

If you wish to hold a civil marriage ceremony in a district outside the region in which you reside, you will need to make contact with both your chosen venue and the superintendent registrar of that district *prior* to giving notice of marriage to your local superintendent registrar. At this stage, your local superintendent registrar will inform you of when your authority to marry is due to be issued.

Your marriage must take place no less than 15 days and no more than twelve months of giving notice.

At your appointment with the registrar, you will be required to provide information about you and your partner including your full names and addresses, your ages, previous marital status, your occupations and your nationalities.

In addition, you are required to prove that you are both free to marry each other and must produce two forms of documentary evidence to the superintendent registrar from the following: Birth certificate, passport, driving license and proof of address.

If you have been married before, you must also produce your decree absolute/your late spouses death certificate. If you have changed you name you must bring your change of name deeds. Any foreign documents should be accompanied by a certified English translation.

Wedding Day Procedure

Prior to the wedding you are both required to have a brief meeting with the Registrar to check all information which is to be entered into the Marriage Register is correct.

The ceremony will be conducted by the Superintendent registrar and registered by the Registrar.

There are words prescribed by law which must be spoken, however are able to personalize your wedding ceremony which can be discussed with the Superintendent Registrar. Please note, it is a legal requirement that a civil wedding ceremony that no aspect of the ceremony (vows, music, readings etc) can be of a religious nature.

Your wedding may legally take place between 8.00am until 6.00pm.

Two people are legally required to witness the ceremony and sign the marriage register.

Booking Procedure

Contact the Superintendent Registrar to check their availability.

Make a provisional booking for your ceremony room hire and estimated accommodation requirements with The Kings Head Hotel which can be held for a period of 14 days with no obligation. During this time, you must make a secure booking with the Superintendent Registrar.

Upon booking the registrar, write to The Kings Head Hotel to confirm you have been granted authority to marry and confirm the time and date of your ceremony. A non-refundable deposit of £500 is required to secure your reservation at The Kings Head Hotel.

Wedding invitations to your Guests should be sent at this time. You may provisionally hold any bedrooms for your Guests for a further period of 14 days from the date of your secure reservation without obligation.

After this period, you are required to confirm Guest numbers and your accommodation requirements, and return a completed Room List to The Kings Head Hotel. Your Guests should then contact the Kings Head Hotel personally to secure their accommodation reservation. Guests are then responsible for rooms booked in their name by themselves. You remain responsible for any rooms booked in your name.

In the next few weeks, you should revisit The Kings Head Hotel to discuss your specific requirements with our Wedding Coordinator and Head Chef. At this stage you will organise the fine details of your Wedding Day including choosing your menus and creating your Wedding Day itinerary. We suggest that during this visit to The Kings Head Hotel, you also visit your chosen local companies to discuss your arrangements for flowers, photography and the like.

Final numbers must be confirmed 4 weeks prior to the wedding. Your final invoice will be based on these numbers, unless these numbers increase. Whilst we will make every effort to accommodate changes to your requirements, we can not guarantee that we are able to make alterations after this date. Children's menus and specific dietary requirements for your Guests must be confirmed by this time.

Terms & Conditions

Payment Terms

Upon securing your reservation, we require a non-refundable deposit of £500. You are able to make payments of any amount toward your wedding at any time prior to receiving your final invoice. The final balance will be payable upon departure from the hotel.

Drinks Packages

In the event in which our drinks suppliers are unable to provide us with your original choice we reserve the right to substitute with an alternative of comparable quality.

Evening Entertainments

Final numbers must be confirmed in writing four weeks prior to your Wedding Day. Your final invoice will be based on these numbers. However, any subsequent increase in numbers will be added to your final invoice.

Maximum Numbers

The Kings Head Hotel holds a license under the Marriages Act of 1994 allowing us to host Civil Wedding Ceremonies for up to 50 Guests in our Blencathra Suite. We are also able to cater for up to a maximum of 50 persons for your Wedding Breakfast. There is no maximum numbers limit for your evening celebrations.

Cancellation Policy

We strongly advise that you take insurance for your wedding. In the event of a cancellation the following charges will be applicable:

More than 8 weeks: Deposit paid

Between 8- and 4-weeks' notice: 75% of the final invoice. Less than 4 weeks: 100% of the final invoice.

The final invoice is based on the value of your booking for accommodation, your wedding breakfast and drinks packages, as detailed in your confirmation letter or final invoice.
